ELIGIBILITY

Only full-time residents of the State of Utah may enter the Super State Championship. A USA Wrestling Utah card is required for all participants. Wrestlers may only compete in one division and one weight class. Only 9th graders who have completed their High School season may participate.

GRADE EFFECTIVE DATE

A wrestler's grade division classification is determined by his/her grade during the 2011-12 school year. (example: a wrestler is in the 6th grade on 1/1/2012. That wrestler competes in the 5th/6th grade division)

FORMAT

Double elimination (no true second).

AWARDS

Trophies for the top six finishers in each weight class. 4-ft trophy for each champion plus a custom Utah State Champion singlet.

SEEDING

Seeding for all age groups will be determined by committee with last year's Super State and other high-level tournaments taken into consideration.

PLACEMENT MATCHES

The six wrestlers advancing to the Super State Championship placement matches in the 3/4, 5/6, 7-9 grade divisions in their weight-class will be featured in a Finals ceremony on Saturday, February 4 at approximately 6:00pm followed by the placement matches.

COACHES

USAU Utah Coach membership required to receive matside credentials. A hospitality room will be available to the Head Coach of each USAU Utah affiliated club.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Participants may only compete in one weight class and one division. No Double Bracketing.
2. There is no weight allowance.
3. A wrestler cannot wrestle outside his/her school class, unless he/she weighs more than the heaviest weight class in his/her school class.
4. USAU, National Federation and UHSAA rules will govern all matches except as follows:
 - a. All Pre-K/K bouts will consist of three periods of 1-1-1.
 - b. All 1st/2nd, 3rd/4th, 5th/6th & 7th-9th bouts in the championship bracket will consist of three periods of 2-1-1.
 - c. All Consolation matches will consist of three periods of 1-1-1.
 - d. Overtime to be 1 minute sudden death followed by one (1) 30-second ride out period.
5. HEADGEAR IS REQUIRED FOR SUPER STATE CHAMPIONSHIP
6. Mouth Guards are recommended for participants with braces.
7. GRADE CHALLENGE RULE – Challenger and Challenged must provide proof of grade (Bring your Report card with you).
8. The hair rule for the Utah Super State tournament will be enforced.
9. Shoe laces must be secured.
